vp: membership

vp: membership serves on the chapter management team (CMT) and chairs the Evaluating Committee (EVC). Based on chapter committee structure and size, the vp: membership works with (or fulfills the responsibilities of): the director of recruitment records, director of primary recruitment, director of continuous recruitment, a recruitment committee and a song leader committee. Successful chapters host engaging and collaborative Recruitment Preparation Workshops (RPWs), utilize strong chapter leaders for recruitment roles (day chairs, spirit squads, etc.) and facilitate cohesive and confidential EVC meetings.
