Chapters with more than 75 members should have an alternate Panhellenic delegate, though smaller chapters may also choose to have this position. They report to the vice president: Panhellenic and serve on the joint chapter management team (JCMT). In the absence of the vp: Panhellenic, this position is the chapter's main representative to the College Panhellenic (CPH). She stays informed of all Panhellenic matters in the event she needs to act as the "voice" for her Delta Gamma chapter in a Panhellenic setting or forum.
