COLLEGIATE DIRECTOR QUICK GUIDE

director of rituals

All chapter sizes should have a director of rituals. They report to the vice president: member education and serve on the joint chapter management team (JCMT). The director of rituals plans and implements all formal, informal and new member ritual ceremonies, and educates the chapter about the value and meaning of Fraternity rituals. Depending on chapter size and structure, they oversee a rituals committee.

- Rituals committee meetings (as needed, at least one per term, more frequently leading up to Inspiration & Initiation).
- You will be copied on the vp: member education newsletter every month. Make sure you read this!
- Your chapter's events ... members need to see you participating!
