WHAT IS AN ALUMNAE DEVELOPMENT CONSULTANT (ADC)?

An ADC is a skilled Delta Gamma alumnae expert who is a volunteer for the Fraternity. In her role, she supports alumnae groups by helping them understand and achieve the [Fraternity Standards for Alumnae Groups](#). She serves as your group's primary Fraternity contact.

THE ADC'S ROLE

- Evaluates the status of your alumnae group.
- Creates a comprehensive plan to help your group succeed. She works with the group members/officers in coordination with the regional team to execute the plan.
- Educates and trains your group's officers.
- Assists with revitalization efforts including officer recruitment and member engagement.
- Visits your group to provide face-to-face support.

YOUR GROUP'S ROLE

- Communicate with your ADC.
- Seek support and resources from your ADC.
- Ask questions!
- Welcome her when she visits! To ensure we utilize Fraternity resources well, aim to provide overnight accommodations and transportation whenever possible.
- Encourage members in your group to participate in activities when the ADC visits.
