 - Donor engagement
 - Human resources
 - Law
 - Marketing
 - Other board experience
 - Previous Delta Gamma experience
 - Strategic planning
- A Foundation Trustee serves a three-year term with a maximum of two terms. After completing a first term, the nominee may be re-slotted for a second term.
- Nominees should communicate their willingness, time and potential to fulfill the obligations inherent of the position.
- Trustees are required to disclose in writing any potential conflicts of interest.
