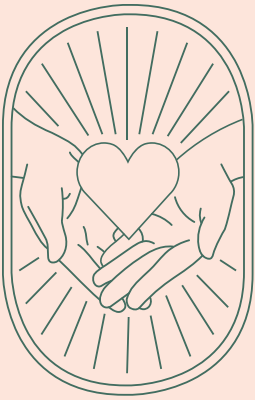

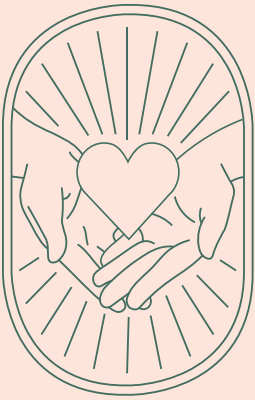


"We talk so much about lasting impact and the legacies that we leave behind; scholarships through the Foundation are prime examples of members creating lasting impact for others."

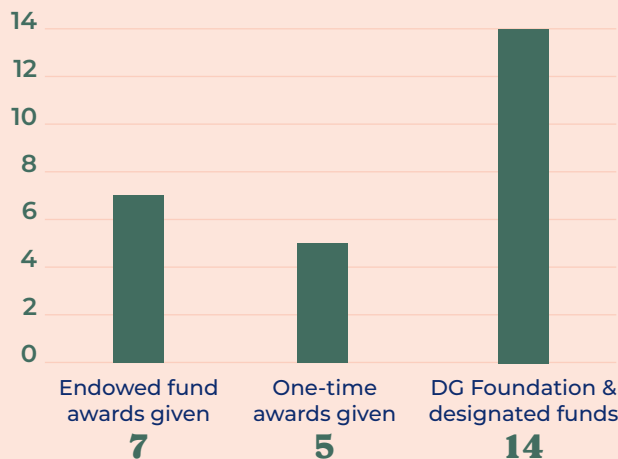

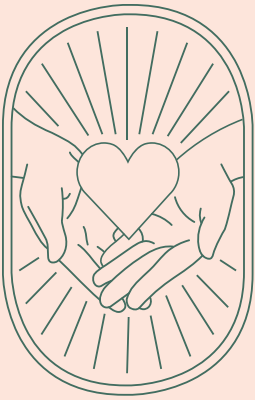

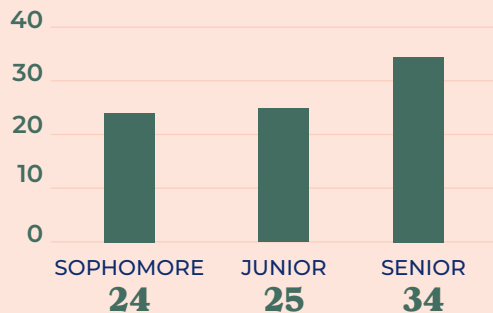

RECIPIENTS BY YEAR IN SCHOOL



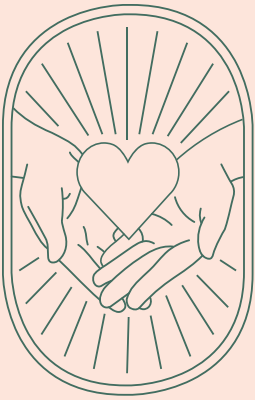

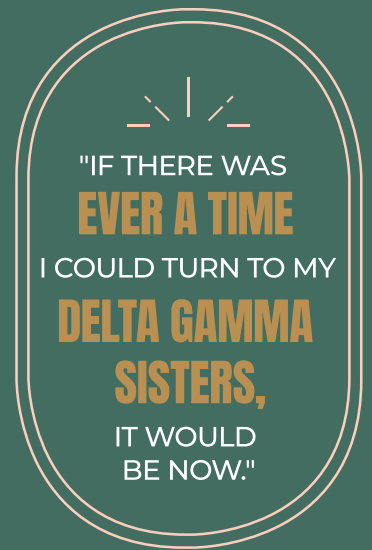
