The Collegiate Advisory Board (CAB) is an annual, standing focus group of collegians that provide the Fraternity with a collegiate perspective on issues, programs and more.

PURPOSE

- Serve as an advisory body to the Fraternity as a voice of collegians on issues facing college students and the Fraternity system;
- Give feedback and suggestions on programs and communication pieces from Delta Gamma involving/targeting collegians;
- Provide a forum for exploring collegiate issues and collecting collegiate feedback;
- Offer suggestions and insights into Fraternity policy and operations from a collegian's perspective.


TIMELINE

- [Applications](#) for the CAB open Monday, October 30, and close Friday, December 1.
- Applicants will be informed regarding their selection by Wednesday, January 10, 2024.
- Board members will serve from January to December 2024.



SELECTING CAB MEMBERS

- The Director: Chapter Support will review all applications for the CAB, as well as any information from each applicant's advisory team chair (ATC) or Honor Board adviser (HBA) through the [required ATC/HBA certification](#). Applicants who are not in good standing will not be considered. Members who are individually in good status, but whose chapters may be in poor standing with the Fraternity, are still eligible to apply.
- You must be an enrolled student through December 2024. Applicants who are on Excused Status at any point during the year are still eligible to serve on the CAB, provided they can commit to making the calls.
- The Director: Chapter Support will then convene a selection committee, consisting of herself and additional Fraternity volunteers, to review the applications and select CAB members.
- To create a truly representative Board, an effort will be made to include:
 - Freshmen, sophomores, juniors and seniors who will have a 5th year;
 - Both officers and non-officers;
 - Members from semester and quarter schools;

- Members from private and public universities;
- Members from small schools, medium and large schools;
- Members from small, medium and large chapters;
- Members from various regions;
- Members pursuing various academic majors; and,
- Members who are actively involved in a variety of campus activities and/or employment outside of Delta Gamma.

DUTIES OF BOARD MEMBERS

- CAB members may be asked to review program proposals, videos, online learning opportunities and more.
- If the Fraternity is considering multiple different programs on a given topic, the CAB may be asked to evaluate the programs and give feedback as to which they prefer, and why.
- The CAB will convene by conference call/video once per month. The monthly calls will take place on **the third Tuesday of every month**, at 6 p.m. PT/7 p.m. MT/8 p.m. CT/9 p.m. ET.
- CAB members may be sent information for their review prior to the call. Board members are expected to spend time reviewing all documents provided so that they are able to fully participate in the discussion.
- CAB members are expected to attend and actively participate in at least 8 of the 10 calls during their tenure. Members who cannot attend a call must email the Director: Chapter Support at least 48 hours in advance. Individuals who miss more than two calls may be subject to removal from the CAB.
