

What you need:

- · 4 pieces of different colored paper
- 84 buttons
- glue
- hole punch
- metal 1-inch book ring

Steps:

- Fold into 6 squares (first fold is "hot dog" and then fold into thirds)
 squares HAVE TO BE EQUAL do not cut paper until it is equal
- 2. Cut all four pieces of paper until you have 26 squares.
- 3. Hole punch the top left corner of each of the 26 pieces of paper.
- 4. Reference the braille alphabet for the correct placement of the buttons (the solid dots are where the buttons will go).
- 5. Glue the buttons on for each letter on each piece of paper. Make sure not to use too much glue, but make sure that the buttons are secure to the paper.
- 6. Check that all the letters are in the correct order and buttons are glued the correct way.
- 7. Complete the book by adding a metal 1-inch book ring to the corner.

Tips:

- This service event requires a lot of planning.
- Be sure to give ample time for the glue under the buttons to dry so the papers do not stick together when stacked.
- \cdot You can have members work on this project individually or in pairs.
