The Redefine the Path (RTP) progam is coming to the Delta Gamma chapter you advise! As a direct supporter of Delta Gamma, we want to give you an overview of this exciting programming and how we plan to do good by promoting belonging, equity, inclusion and diversity (BEID).

WHAT IS REDEFINE THE PATH?

This workshop is designed to support organizations interested in considering how their chapters can engage in behavior dedicated to belonging, equity, inclusion and diversity (BEID). This interactive workshop invites chapter members to learn how to incorporate BEID organizational values within the sorority experience through shared strategies, approaches, and resources to create a better chapter experience and environment where belonging is prioritized.

HOW WAS MY CHAPTER SELECTED?

All Delta Gamma chapters will receive RTP every four years in a rotation format. This is one of the many educational programs delivered to chapters on a scheduled, rotational basis. Delta Gamma continues to be committed to providing our collegiate members with unparalleled educational opportunities and resources. When a chapter receives RTP, it will count as the educational and cultural interests program for DG Dialogues.

WHO SHOULD ATTEND REDEFINE THE PATH?

Delta Gamma's goal is for all collegiate members to participate in RTP, with every chapter having 100% attendance for their presentation. New members are expected to attend and will count in the roster total. Provided along with this chapter preparation guide is the Act with Intention: Health & Well-Being Series Terms & Conditions which will further outline chapter attendance expectations. This program is meant to be a conversation shared only between the chapter members and trained facilitators. To encourage open dialogue and honest reflection, we ask that advisers, house directors and other members of the fraternity/sorority community do not attend the presentation.

WHO WILL FACILITATE THE PROGRAM?

Delta Gamma has selected a team of trained facilitators to help bring RTP to our chapters. The facilitation team consists of CDCs, higher education professionals, staff from other fraternity and sorority headquarters and Delta Gamma alumnae. The chapter will be informed of their facilitator through an introduction email.

WHAT IS THE TIME/DATE FOR REDEFINE THE PATH?

Collegians will be responsible for working with the assigned facilitator to select a date and time that is mutually agreed upon for the program. They must work with your facilitators' availability to set the date and time of the workshop. The program will take two hours to facilitate.
