### TRUSTEE ROLE OVERVIEW

**Board Structure:** The Delta Gamma Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization, and as a Trustee, you will serve on a governing board dedicated to supporting its mission and initiatives, furthering the values that are central to Delta Gamma.

**Term Length:** Serve a three-year term, with a maximum of two terms.

**First Term Start Date:** July 1, 2025

**Meetings:** Trustees meet virtually monthly and in person three times per year, with a time commitment of 16-18 weekday or weekend days per year, including travel.

**Make a Lasting Impact:** As a Trustee, you'll guide the Foundation's growth and future.

**Support a Cause You Love:** You'll be directly involved in initiatives that support Delta Gamma sisters and our philanthropy.

**Passionate Advocates:** A sister who believes in the Delta Gamma Foundation's mission and is ready to promote its goals and initiatives.

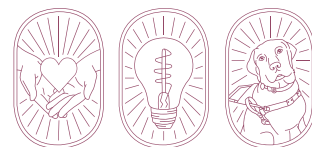
**Time and Commitment:** A sister who is ready to dedicate the time and energy needed to attend meetings and participate in the Foundation's activities.
