Lewis Institute Attendee Chapter Presentation Guide

Thank you for your willingness to share more about your Lewis Institute experience in your chapter! We hope you left Lewis Institute feeling inspired and connected... now here is your chance to share some of your experience with members of your chapter.

Step 1: Reflect

Before you share you present on your Lewis Institute experience, take some time to gather your thoughts (and photos!) about your experience. If there was another member of your chapter who attended Lewis Institute this summer, start by reflecting individually.

Here are some prompts to help you gather your thoughts:

- What were some of the sessions you enjoyed most at Lewis Institute? Why?
- What were your biggest takeaways from Lewis Institute?
- What is something you will always remember from your Lewis Institute experience?
- What did you create your action plan(s) about?
- Would you encourage someone to attend Lewis Institute in the future? Why?
- How would you describe your Lewis Institute experience in one sentence?

Step 2: Identify a Time to Share

Connect with your chapter's CMT to pick a time that might work for you to present your experience. You will likely need 10-15 minutes to present.

Step 3: Complete the PowerPoint Template

Use the provided PowerPoint or [Canva template](#) (or create your own!) to fill in your experiences and photos. If there is another member of your chapter who attended Lewis Institute, be sure to work together to create this presentation. The notes section of the PowerPoint slides provide directions and recommended talking points to help guide your presentation.

Remember that while sharing the basic information about Lewis Institute is important, it is more impactful for members to hear about your personal experience! Share the answers from your prompts in Step 1 or any other thoughts you want to ensure that members know about your time at Lewis.
